# Missions

The post-doctoral fellow will contribute to the Citizens project (CITIZENS' Implication in public decision, <u>https://www.gate.cnrs.fr/Citizens/</u> funded by the French National Agency for Research. Faced with the rise of abstention rate over the past decades, the ambition of this project is to study the microeconomic determinants of citizens' involvement in public decision making.

Our project aims to explore the causal impact of decentralization on voter turnout, and assess with econometric techniques how the different form of decentralization and the different form of local governance could bring closer the citizens and elected officials at the local level.

Most precisely, the post-doctoral researcher will use econometric analysis (panel, quasi experiment, simulations) on local public data to assess the impact of local competencies, voting methods, and socio-economic characteristics on the voting turnout. The post-doctoral researcher will participate un activities such as collecting and managing data, developing theoretical models, and using adequate econometric techniques to analyze them.

The post-doctoral researcher willl work in CREM, Rennes, under the supervision of Benoit Le Maux, Vincent Merlin and Sonia Paty, and will collaborate with the other members of the CITIZENS project.

# Activities

The post-doctoral researcher will help in managing and collecting date, and write scientific papers. He/She will attend the workshops and research seminars organized at CREM Rennes, and will help organizing them. He/She will present her works in seminar as well as in French and international conferences. He/She will participate to the dissemination activities of the CITIZENS project.
